#### **1. Background and Purposes:**

In order to continue the spirit of Taipei Declaration for Asian Industrial Heritage, which issued in the 15th Conference of International Committee for the Conservation of Industrial Heritage (TICCIH Congress 2012), the Asian Network of Industrial Heritage (ANIH) was officially launched in March 2018 in Taiwan. As mentioned in the statement, ‘We recognize that both national and trans-national industrial heritage are equally important and the need of the future cooperation between Asian countries to promote the conservation of them is crucial’, ANIH aims at motivating the industrial heritage cooperation across the Asia.

Featuring the theme of “The Connection of the Genealogy of Industrial Heritage in the Asia-Pacific Region”, the 3rd Forum on Asian Industrial Heritage Conservation invites experts and individuals across the industrial heritage societies to study the topics in lineages, connectivity, and the sustainable practices of industrial heritage. Through the youth dialogue and participations, it is expected to empower the development of industrial heritage preservation.
